- Emergency Preparedness Definition from The National Fire Protection Association (NFPA): "Activities, tasks, programs, and systems developed and implemented prior to an emergency that are used to support the prevention of, mitigation of, response to and recovery from emergencies."

 - Start to work your plan into place
